Please read these notes:

It is an offence, if any person, for any purpose connected with the FNPF Act:-

- i) knowingly makes a false statement or
- ii) produces or furnishes or causes or knowingly allows to be produced or furnished any document which he knows to be false in a material particular.

Special Warning

A. It is not compulsory to withdraw after attaining the age of 55. If you so wish, you may leave your money in the Provident Fund and withdraw at a later date.

An employee who has withdrawn the amount standing to his credit in the Fund on the ground that he has reached the age of 55 may at a time give notice to his employer that he wishes to rejoin the Fund. Thereafter he is not gain entitled to withdraw until one year has lapsed.

A member who withdraws and re-enters the Fund must be re-registered by completing a registration form.

B. Special Death Benefit

After rejoining, in the event of your death, your nominees will not be entitled to a special death benefit. No charge towards premium will be made.

C. Pension Eligibility

You will be eligible to opt for a pension only if:-

- a. You are withdrawing for the first time after attaining the age 55 years,
- b. You having withdrawn after 01/01/1975 on the ground of migration or marriage being a woman, re-entered the Fund and are now applying on the ground of attaining 55 years of age.

Note: If you withdraw and then rejoin, you do not contribute to the Pension Buffer Fund and will not be entitled to pension.

D. Pension Options

- a. If you do not wish to opt for a pension, the full amount will be paid to you.
- b. A pension option form will be sent after your account has been updated to show the amount of pension payable.
- c. Pension option types are as follows:-
 1. **Life/Sole Pension** - Life/Sole pension is only payable to the member and ceases upon death of member. If the pensioner dies within the first twelve months, then the balance for the first twelve months is payable to the nominee.
 2. **Joint Pension** - Joint pension is payable to the member and is transferred to the legal spouse of the member upon member's death.
 3. **Part Lump Sum and Part Life/Sole Pension**
 4. **Part Lump Sum and Part Joint Pension**
 5. **Part Lump Sum and Part Life/Sole Pension and Part Joint Pension.**

Please feel free to discuss the Pension options with our Pension Advisory officers.

Method of Payment

- i) **Bank Deposit:** Ensure that you bank account is correctly written in this form. Telegraphic transfers are permitted. Note that your payment cannot be deposited into an account which is not in your name.
- ii) **Mailing:** Please provide a reliable overseas postal address for bank draft.
- iii) **Payment through Bank Disbursement:** For members who do not have Bank accounts. Funds are transferred to a special account at the bank and members are paid cash on producing FNPF identification and confirmation that funds have been transferred. FNPF photo ID is required.
